Morocco's Infrastructure Drive: Bridging the \$37 Billion Investment Gap by 2040.

With a focused approach on roads, ports, airports, and rail links, Morocco aims to bridge its projected \$37 billion infrastructure investment gap by 2040. Energy emerges as a top priority, with renewables receiving over half of the upcoming \$4 billion investment.

Transportation leads ongoing projects, comprising 68% of investments. Morocco's strategic plans, such as the 2040 Rail Strategy and the Noor Ouarzazate solar plan, position it as an appealing destination for infrastructure investments. Moreover, as Morocco competes to co-host the FIFA 2030 World Cup, substantial funding is directed towards vital infrastructure projects, propelling growth and development."
